This can be exemplified through the successful development and implementation of a special project or program, librarian/faculty collaboration that advances IL, or integration of IL into non-library course &/or campus objectives. There are no restrictions as to the size of the instructional effort, discipline, target audience, or techniques employed. Self nominations are encouraged.

ELIGIBILITY

The candidate (or representative member of a librarian-led team) must

- be a current WAAL member
- be employed at a Wisconsin academic institution
- agree to attend the WAAL annual conference to receive the award and present a program discussing the exemplary activity, project or program
