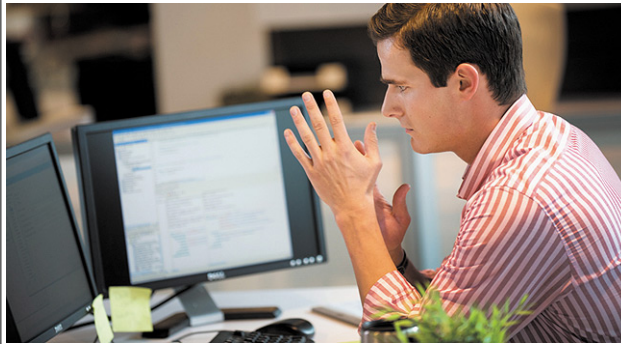
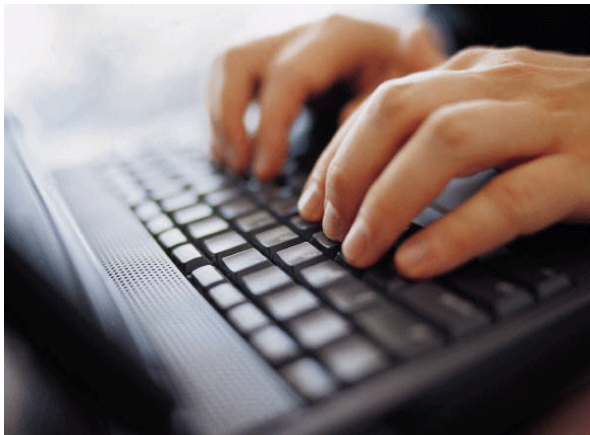

Students will assist campus Information Technology staff in:

- **Technical support of distance education classes**
- **Troubleshooting and repairing hardware problems**
- **Help desk support for student computer labs**
- **Desktop support for faculty, staff, and students**
- **Other responsibilities as assigned**



Program highlights include:

- Competitive salary
- Training at UW-Marathon County during the week of June 20, 2011 in Wausau, WI including, meals, and housing. Travel expenses will be paid per UW policy and students will be paid their starting hourly wage for the training.
- Up to 10, thirty hour weeks of employment Summer 2011.
- Employment during the school year (2011-2012) beginning September 2011 in the IT department at your local campus. Students will average 15 hours/week for 30 weeks.
- Summer employment after freshman year at your campus working in the IT department. Approximately 14 weeks.
- Employment during sophomore year (2012-2013) working an average of 15 hours/week.
- \$1,000 bonus for the second year of participation in the program.
